 - <u>PrettyGoodStickers</u> seems to be a very good alternative (at least within Europe).
 - Quality and price are good, but cutting can be a bit off. They suggested a solution to avoid cutting issues which seems to work well:



- If CAB agrees I (jo) will add a short guide on how to prepare stickers for prettygoodstickers to the <u>BiocStickers repository</u> - unless that's considered unwanted advertisement? Stevie: local facility in Australia to print, but not online ordering. But having a guide would be helpful. CAB agrees.

:34 - :40 R-Ladies engagement | R-Ladies @ BioC [Janani]

- Prepared blog post will be (re-)evaluated by the R-Ladies.
- Synchronized posting of the "official" (final) blog post.
- Aim: organize watch parties of Bioconductor conferences through R-Ladies chapters.
- For the last Bioconductor conference a table was organized and a watch party was organized in Colorado (very successful).
- Discussion: how to best organize local watch parties for events. Maybe sign-up list/directory.
- Watch party options through R Ladies:
 - Live watching through youtube OR the BioC platform? Who pays for this? Or can CAB bear these costs | 1 virtual registration per chapter? US BioC conference uses a platform for video recording and casting, not directly through youtube. They get uploaded afterwards on youtube (but that's manual work of volunteers). Maybe the watch party can register to the platform and the registration fee gets waived.
 - Watch youtube stream afterwards

- Discussion on Seurat in Bioconductor and enforcement of Bioconductor class structures as well as Seurat's lack of accreditation to lifted Bioconductor methods. A dedicated effort to a conversion package might prove useful
- NHGRI renewal process reviewed as we will submit a renewal in Feb. 2025

- **CAB specific item**: Should we synchronize useR and Bioc conferences or other larger meetings like ASA? Should we start having specialized smaller 'conferences' on dedicated subjects?
 - Jo: have dedicated hackathon/birds of a feature at topical conferences (e.g. metabolomics) to bring developers together. Depends on willingness of the conference organizers.
 - JR: Is this topical? Or regional satellite meetings?
 - Leo: better support sub-communities. Bring developers from the same topic together.
 - JR: have mini-symposia within a conference, half a day or some hours.
 Virtual would have the advantage of having it worldwide at least 2x time zones.
 - JR: webinar series | CAB + working group coordination | work with the BioC directory with omic + regional tags | can also focus on early career developers (they usually don't get invited to larger meetings)
 - Leo: having funding for that would be important. Maybe Bioconductor might get funding easier.
- TAB suggested meeting format change where each member takes a week to prepare/moderate on a specific topic of interest to encourage involvement (although reluctant to volunteer)
